## EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Situated in the Township of Colerain, County of Belmont, and in the State of Ohio. Being part of the southeast quarter of Section 14, Township 7, Range 3, and being the remaining portion of a 6.86-acre tract recorded as Tract Two in Volume 344, Page 321, and being all of a 1.00-acre tract recorded as Tract One in Volume 344, Page 321 of the Belmont County Record of Deeds.
