- 7. That Union Bank is entitled to foreclose its Mortgage.
- 8. That the Mortgage described in the Foreclosure Action is the valid and subsisting lien on the property commonly known as 702 E. Jackson Street, Delphos, Allen County, Ohio 45833 ("Property") and more fully described as follows:
