DESCRIPTION OF 1.67 ACRE TRACT

R. #257, to a railroad spike set and marking the principal place of beginning, said spike being in the east line of said Ackley's "87 and 10 81/100/160" acre tract; thence North 7° 00' West 110.00 feet, continuing along the centerline of S.R.#257, to a railroad spike set at a deflection point in said road; thence North 4° 00' East 90.00 feet, continuing along the centerline of said road, to a railroad spike set; thence North 78° 48' 30" West 227.30 feet, departing said road, and passing through an iron pin set for reference at 30.24 feet, to an iron pin set; thence South 88° 36' 30" West 139.65 feet to an iron pin set; thence South 5° 32' East 200.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence South 83° 24' East 352.76 feet, passing through an iron pin set for reference at 321.90 feet, to the principal place of beginning, containing 1.67 acres, more or less, and subject to any valid easements or restrictions of record.
